## The Indian Way.

Even the admirers of Lo, the poor Indian, will not be particularly impressed with humanity of a lot of Mojave Indians recently manifested in Southern California, not far from Los Angeles. And the unbeliever in the Indian's alleged noble traits of character will find in the incident a new reason for treating the savages less like a white man and more like an animal.

An epidemic of malignant typhoid fever ravaged this tribe and from its effects many of the Mojave braves died. No sooner was a Mojave stricken with the disease than the life was almost beaten out of him with sticks in order to exercise the evil spirit. After the beating the poor patient was dragged through the Colorado River in order that the cleansing process might be complete. It may easily be imagined that this vigorous treatment did not have an ameliorating effect on the patient. There being no cessation in the epidemic, a council was held at which it was decided that the disease was caused by the presence of a witch in the tribe. How to find the witch was the next proceeding. A large pot was secured and filled with herbs. When the contents of the pot had been boiled down to about a teacupful of liquid, a white pigeon and its white mate were taken from a basket near by and the decoction poured down their throats. The male bird flew away he was released and, naturally enough, did not return. The dose was too much for the female pigeon, which died after fluttering about for a few minutes. This incident fairly frenzied the bucks. It was a sort of corroboration of the charge that a witch was in the camp and, farther, pointed to the fact that it was a female witch. All of the women were driven out of the tents to where the council was held, and, forming them in single file, the bucks drove the squaws past the dead pigeon, which had not been removed from the spot where it died. One unfortunate Indian maiden, impelled either by curiosity or pity for the dead pigeon, which looked like a lump of snow in the moonlight, stepped out of the file to pick it up. This according to Indian logic, was all the evidence necessary to convince them that she was the witch. Accordingly, with fearful yells, she was captured and pinioned, stripped of her clothing and then and there tied to a stake. A slow fire was built under her and for two hours she lingered in the most frightful agony, the victim's death screams and the bucks' vocal noises making the night hideous. The whitened bones of the 18-years-old girl and the dead embers of the fire told the story of her fate the next morning with convincing eloquence.

The Indians are called the wards of the government. Then the government has control over them. Is it not the duty of the United States authorities to prevent such horrible atrocities as this as well as to feed the Indian and to provide him with shelter? Because an Indian satisfies his ridiculous belief by burning this innocent girl does not make it one whit the less a murder. And if it is murder why should not some punishment be meted out as a warning to future offenders? If an Indian kills a white man he is amenable to our laws. If he kills another Indian he should also be held for murder. The fact that there were incantations and absurd tests employed before this brutal sacrifice of life does not in the least mitigate the offense. A wholesome dread on the part of these brutes of the power of civilized society would be beneficial. Punish some of the braves who take a part in like atrocities and there would be less in the future to record. A civilized government should not permit such a fearful outrage in its midst.
