Our Town Library.

Our townspeople are to be congratulated for the enterprise with which they take hold of, and support any new suggestions, for the improvement of the town, that may be brought to their notice. The latest step forward is the starting of a fine circulating Library. We have for some time felt the want of one for reference and for general use. We have tried several plans, but have found they were not practical for the maintenance and growth of a Library in a town as small as ours.

Mr. Harry Fisher representing Thomas J. Collins of Haddonfield, N. J., was in town a few days last week, and introduced their plan for the establishment of small town Libraries, which certainly has proved itself a thorough success. Our Middleburgh Library was opened to the subscribers, last Saturday evening, and found to be far superior to anything we could have expected when the small amount of money it required was taken into consideration. The books are of good size, some containing over 800 pages, and are strongly bound. They present a handsome appearance on the shelves, where Dr. L. Grier Barber, the Librarian has placed them. The Library contains valuable histories, and historical novels, religious and scientific works, travels, discovery and adventure. The taste for wit and humor, so prevalent among our people was considered in the selection made. The fiction is of the highest grade, and so interspersed that taking the Library as a whole, there could not have been made a selection better suited to please the stockholders, and to elevate the tastes of the whole community.

Three gentlemen come to us with first class recommendations, and we take great pleasure in introducing them to our friends, and hope our neighboring towns may have the opportunity offered to start a Library like ours.
