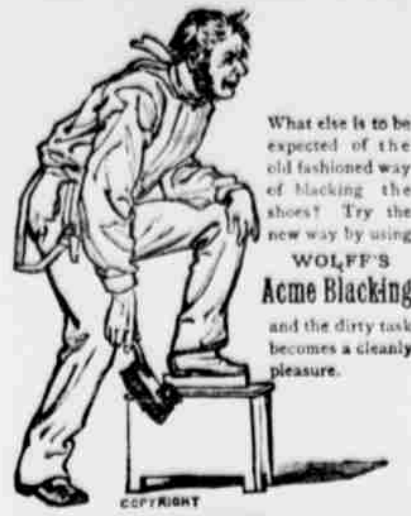

**For the Poor. Mission Work in Baltimore.**

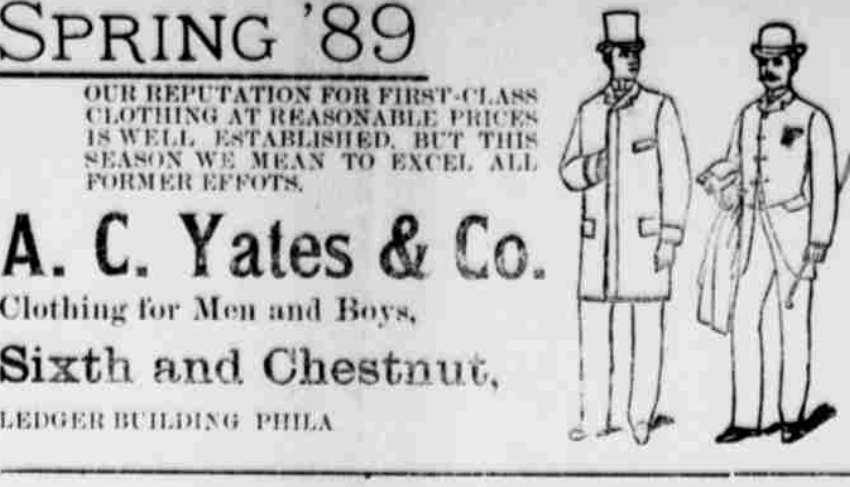
There is no question which agitates the mind of christian workers more than, "How shall we bring into the Sunday school and church those who have no desire to come? and yet of the number who are conscious of the great work to be done there are comparatively few who are willing to "Live for the good we may do." A little more than twelve years ago a noble christian man in this city gathered together a few children one Sunday afternoon, in a little room over a blacksmith shop, and there opened a Sunday school. On the following sabbath three ladies and one gentleman came as his co-workers, and together they went out into the alleys and streets and brought in men, women and children, and there told them the Story of the Cross. The number multiplied by scores and hundreds, and at this present time this Sunday school has one of the largest edifices in the city, with an average scholarship of thirteen hundred and thirty eight, of the large force of teachers and officers, it is, and has been the universal thought, how to win them to Christ, and in this is their secret of success, as for the fruits of their labor, very many are now devoted christians and almost the entire congregation of the "Faith" Presbyterian church can trace the turning point in their lives to this Sunday school. For the past two years the Immanuel Baptist congregation has sent out two ladies who devote their entire time to this work. Almost daily they come in contact with poverty in all its forms. Many of these children are provided with proper clothing and then brought into the Sunday school, through the untiring efforts of these noble women. It is not unfrequently that families are found who are entire strangers to their Creator, even in this "city of churches." There is also in connection with this church an "Industrial school" of about one hundred girls, whose ages range from seven to fifteen years. The pastor of this congregation, Dr. A. C. Dixon recently preached a special sermon for boys, taking as his subject "The Boyhood of Jesus." The entire service was a most impressive one, as the pastor earnestly prayed to God to help these boys, especially the poor boys who often went out from their homes hungry and thinly clad to battle with the many temptations around them, and who often felt the need of a friend to help them. Of this motley crowd of boys, many faces showed that their better nature was touched as they rubbed the trickling tears from their cheeks. And who of us will dare to say "There are not times in life when the great God owns a sigh for a prayer." Please allow me to quote a few of his remarks. "I am glad Jesus Christ was a boy. He was a poor boy and knows just how to sympathize and comfort you. He was surrounded with wickedness, Nazareth was a wicked place, and hence He knows what grace and strength you need to turn from evil and lead a pure life. Although sin may be all about you, He was an industrious boy, toiling day after day with plane and saw, thus teaching the important lesson that boys should not be idle. He was a temperate boy. We are told He grew in wisdom and stature, he was not a stunted boy from the use of cigars and tobacco." All through the sermon he held that large audience spell-bound from the boot-black to the boy from the home of luxury and wealth. Eternity alone will tell what the harvest will be from the seed so surely planted in the hearts of those boys. There are in this city others who are faithfully laboring for the Master, but with whom the writer is not personally acquainted.

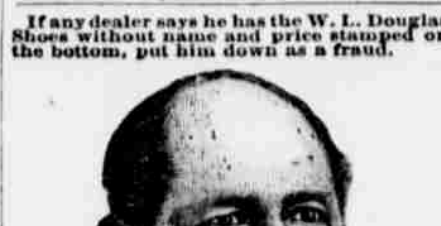
