Your bright boy, Johnnie is all right now; but there is no knowing the mischief he may get into, and cause your name to be known in a police court.

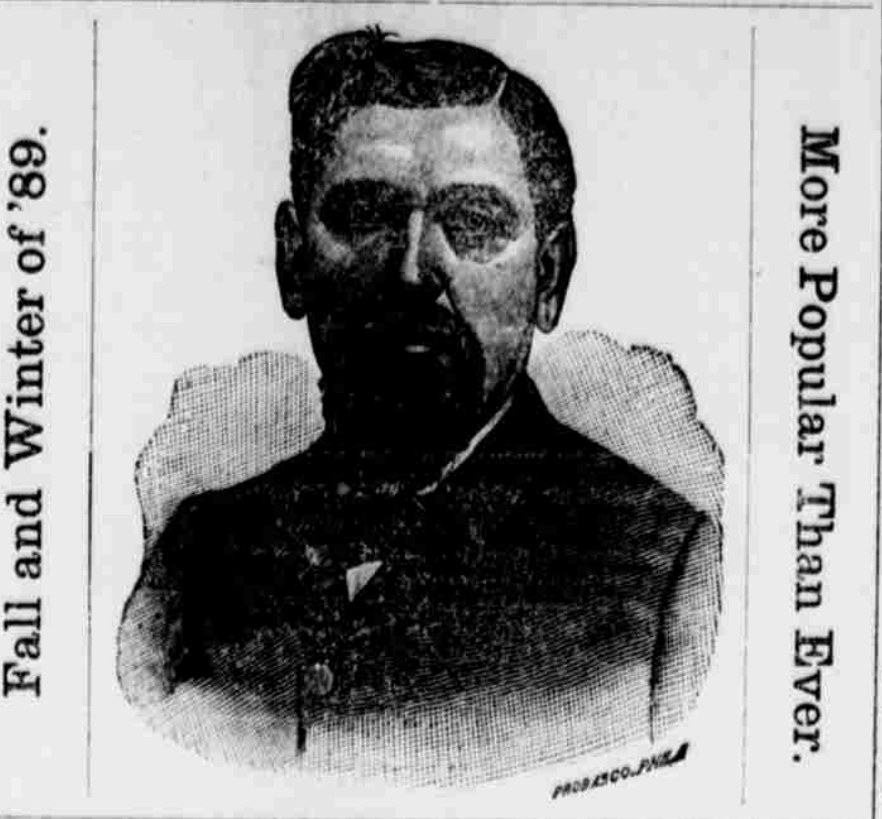
You have in contemplation a journey. Now it is quite possible that it may be your last, and terminate in a country or locality for which you had not purchased a ticket.
