Court Proclamation. WHEREAS the Hon. Joseph G. Bucher, President Judge of the Judicial District, composed of the counties of Snyder, Union and Mifflin, and Samuel A. Weigel and Henry Brown Esqs., Associate Judges in and for Snyder county, have issued their precept, bearing date the 12th day of Dec., A. D., 1890, to me directed for the holding of an Orphans' Court, a Court of Common Pleas, Court of Oyer and Terminer and General Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace, at Middleburgh, for the county of Snyder, on the 4th Monday, (being the 24th day of February 1890), and to continue one week.

Notice is therefore hereby given to the Coroners, Justices of the Peace and Constables in and for the county of Snyder, to appear in their proper person with their rolls, records, inquisitions, examinations, and other remembrances to do those things which of their offices and in their behalf pertain to be done and witnessed and persons presenting in behalf of the County against any person or persons are required to be there and there attending and departing without leave at their peril. 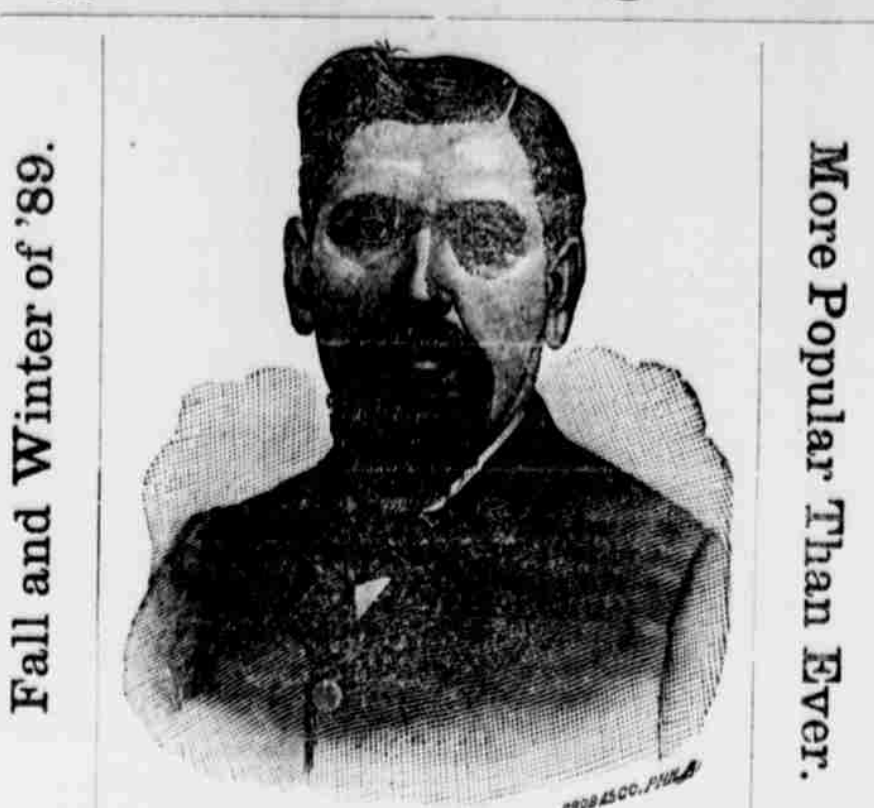
