OTHER NEW CREED PROPOSED

Chicago Presbytery Discusses the Scope of Revision.

The Chicago Presbytery took up the discussion of the question of the revision of the Confession of Faith Monday morning.

Dr. Herrick Johnson's specifications, that the full integrity of the system, that forms especially in their tenth chapter, which convey, or seem to convey erroneous impressions or complications, and which are occasions of stumbling, be modified.

Dr. Woolsey Stryker spoke in favor of the adoption of a new creed, and for the retention introduced by him as a substitute.

Dr. Johnson was given the floor and spoke of his second specification. He said there was not a word about Calvinism in the new creed.

California Votes Against Revision. The vote on the question of revision of the Confession of Faith which was taken by the Synod of San Francisco last October, and which resulted against the revision, was conducted by the Presbytery at the request of a number of members who thought they had sufficient opportunity to discuss the matter.

Nominations. The President sent to the Senate the following nominations: Charles Emery Smith, of Pennsylvania, to be Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary of the United States to Russia.

Items of Interest to Workingmen.—The Eight-Hour Campaign.

Nearly 20 delegates were present at the State eight-hour meeting held in St. Paul, Minn. The first object of discussion was an expression of opinion from all trades represented as to how the eight-hour campaign should be carried on.

The New Castle (Pa.) Wire Nail Company has been chartered. Capital, \$300,000. The Franklin Iron Works will occupy their new building, Green Island, N. Y., about May 1.

One hundred and seventy-five men employed in the Erie Railroad shops at Squehanna, Pa., were suspended last week. Nearly all are single men, and many non-residents.

The Hon. Willis Harnes, of Charleston, Ind., has invented a little machine which is operated by clockwork, and marks automatically, on glass, 30, 30 lines on a space of an inch.

At Dover, New Hampshire, the Sheriff attached 100 machines and the stock in process of manufacture of the Dover Shoe Company's shops, for Walter S. Dickinson, sole leather manufacturer, of Lynn.

The Charlotte (Mich.) Common Council has voted to grant John L. Tolson a bonus of \$3,000 in consideration of his erecting a brick carriage factory, with a capacity for 300 workmen, and have the same in operation by October 1.
