The famous Andersonville prison has been purchased by E. S. Jones Post, G. A. R., of Macon, Georgia. This is the prison where so many Union soldiers perished during the war of rebellion. The purchase includes 80 acres of the stockades and the forts surrounding the enclosure, a driveway 100 feet wide and the right of way from an avenue leading from the depot to the place. It is proposed to lay the ground out into a beautiful park and erect several handsome buildings. The money for the purchase has been paid over, and subscriptions will be received from the posts of the Union to erect the buildings. It is proposed to make the final arrangement to those who fell and at the same time show how thoroughly the country is reunited.
