An Act.

To encourage the raising of horses, mules, cattle, sheep and swine, and to regulate fences in the County of Snyder.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that from and after the passage of this act there shall be no recovery for damages done by any horse, mule, cattle, sheep or swine trespassing upon any real estate within the County of Snyder unless the real estate be enclosed with a good and substantial fence at least four and a half feet in height. Justices are requested to be punctual in their attendance at the meetings appointed time, reasonably to notice.


