MUST RECEIVE PREPAID MAIL MATTER.—The postoffice department at Washington has sent to all railway mail service employes circulars calling attention to the postal regulations requiring postal clerks to accept prepaid mail matter offered them at their cars and forward to its destination. There was a rumor current that this privilege, long enjoyed by the public, was to be denied it, but this comes from headquarters and will settle the matter for the present. Any postal clerk refusing to receive prepaid mail matter at his car is liable to be dismissed from the service unless special authority has been given him.
