"A game bill introduced this week ed a sensation among the sportsmen of the State. It is modeled after
the New York State law and is designed to knock-out the pot hunter and expert bird exterminator who
shoots to slaughter, and to give the average country guaner a chanee to see a feather once in a whine when
out huntiog in the spirit of the true sportsmen, which is for recreation.
The bill provides that no person sbull offer for sale any quail, pheasant or wood.cock, under a penalty
of tive dollacs for each bir1. No of five dollacs for each bir1. No
restaurant keeper or dealer in mer restauran keeper or deater in mer-
chandise shall employ anyone to cap ture or kill any of the birds above mentioned under a penalty of twen-ty-five dollars for each and every
bird purchased. Transportation bird purchased. Transportation
companies are not allowed to re companies are not allowed to re
ceive or transport any birds after ceive have been killed under a penalty of twenty-five dollars. The person making the information and procuring a conviction shall be entited to oue-half of the fine, the other half to go to the game combirds. Every bird killed or trans. ported shall be considered a separate offense. No person shall be prevented from killing any such birds in the lawful season for the use of himself or his family, nor the carrying by suoh person into railroad
trains or common carrier not more than twelve wood-coek at one time and not more than twelye phessants at any one time. The act does no protibit the carrying of birầs killed in other states by transpottation
companies. Where the pot hunter and game butcher gets it in the neck is here: It shall be unlawful to kill in any one day more than five pheas
ants nor more tban eight wood-cock by any one person, under a penalty
of five dollars for each bird killed. If ne can get this bill through th fellow who hunts for the market fo profit, and is hired by the cold stor-
age trusts to go into the rural dis. age trusts to go into the rural dis-
tricts on tours of extermination, will be out of a job, and a few birds will be left for the rural boys and as to secure game.
