Electricity is such a mysteious thing, with something of the black art about it, that nothing reems to be too marvelous to be accomplished by it, and many imposters have reaped, and for that matter are still reaping, a rich harvest by making use of the ignorance and almost childish confidence which the investtag public has in old and new and startling discoveries in electricity, says a correspondent of the Pitts-The electro-medical burg Gazette. appliances which usually can be "writ down" as frauds, with the exception. possibly, of the X-ray, are too many to detail. They are no worse than quack medicines, except that they cost more.
