Amendments to the Constitution. Be is resolved by the Senate and House of kepresentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met. That the following

mendments be proposed to the Constitution of the ommonwealth, in accordance with the provisions of the teath article thereof . There shall be an additional section to the third article of the Constitution to be designated section

Section 4. Whenever any of the qualified elec-tors of this Commonwealth shall be in any active military service, under a requisition from the Presimmonwealth, such electors may exercise the right suffrage in all elections by the citizens, under uch regulations as are or shall be, prescribed by law as fully as if they were present at their usual place of election?

Section 2. There shall be two additional section "Sections." There shall be two abstraints section to the eleventh article of the Constitution, to be designated as sections, eight and nine, as follows:
"Section 8: No bith shall be passed by the legis lature, containing more than one subject which shall be clearly expressed in the tile, except appropria

"Secreen 9 No bill shall be passed by the Legis lature granting any powers, or privileges, in any case, where the authority to grant such powers, or privileges, has been or may hereafter the conferred upon the courts of this Commonwealth." HENRY C. JOHNSON, Speaker of the House of Representatives.
