Therefore I, A. H. GAY, Sheriff of the County of Wyoming, in and by this my Proclamation, do make known to this advertisement, to the Electors of the County of Wyoming that a

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That the Inspectors and Judges chosen as aforesaid shall meet at the respective places appointed for holding the election in the districts to which they respectively belong, before nine o'clock on the morning of the 9th day of October, in each and every year, and each of said Inspectors shall appoint one clerk who shall be a qualified voter of said district.

In case the highest number of votes received shall not attend on the day of Election, the person who shall have received the second highest number of votes for Judge at the preceding election shall act as Inspector in his place. And in case the person who shall have received the highest number of votes for Inspector shall not attend, the person elected Judge shall appoint an Inspector in his place; and in case the person elected Judge shall not attend, then the Inspector who received the highest number of votes shall appoint a Judge in his place, and if any person continues in the district for the space of one hour after the time fixed for the opening of the election of the qualified voters of the township, ward or district, for which such officer shall have been elected, present at the place of election, shall elect one of the qualified voters to fill the vacancy.

In all cases where the names of a person claiming to vote is not to be found on the list furnished by the Commissioners and Assessors, or his right to vote whether found therein or not is objected to by any qualified voter, it shall be the duty of the Inspector to examine such persons on oath as to his qualifications and if he claims to have resided in the State for one year more, his oath shall be sufficient proof thereof; but he shall make proof by at least one competent witness who shall be a qualified elector, and who shall be sworn to make such proof, and shall also himself swear that his bona fide residence, in pursuance of his lawful calling is within the district and that he did not move into the district for the purpose of voting therein.

Every person qualified as aforesaid, and who shall make due proof, if required, of his residence and payment of taxes as aforesaid, shall be admitted to vote in the township, ward or district in which he shall reside.

Any person or persons shall make any bet or wager upon the result of any election in this Commonwealth, or shall offer to make any such bet or wager either by verbal proclamation thereof, or by any written or printed advertisement challenge or otherwise, or shall attempt to make such a bet or wager, upon conviction thereof he or they shall forfeit and pay three times the amount so bet or offered to.

If any person not by law qualified shall fraudulently vote at an election within this Commonwealth, or being otherwise qualified shall vote at the election of his proper district, or if any person knowing the want of such qualification shall aid or procure such person or persons to vote at an election, he or they shall be fined not exceeding two hundred dollars and be imprisoned for a term not exceeding three months.

If any person shall vote at more than one election district, or otherwise fraudulently vote more than once on the same day or shall fraudulently fold or deliver to the Inspectors two tickets together with the intention to fraudulently vote, or shall aid or procure any person to do so, or shall aid or procure any person to do so, he or they shall be fined in any sum not less than fifty nor more than five hundred dollars and be imprisoned for any term not less than three nor more than twelve months.

Any person not qualified to vote in this Commonwealth agreeable to law (excepting the sons of qualified citizens) shall appear at any place of election for the purpose of issuing tickets or influencing citizens qualified to vote, he shall on conviction forfeit and pay any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars for every such offence, and be imprisoned for any term not exceeding three months.

That any person except justices of the peace who shall hold any office or appointment of profit or trust in the government of the United States, or of this State, or of any city or incorporated district, whether a commissioned officer or otherwise—a subordinate officer or agent—who is or who shall be employed under the legislative, executive or judiciary department of the government of the United States, or of any city or incorporated district, and also every member of Congress and of the State Legislature, and of the select or common council of any city, or commissioners of any incorporated district is by law incapable of holding or exercising, at the same time, the office of justice of the peace, Inspector or Clerk of any election within this Commonwealth, and that no Inspector, Judge or other officer of any such election, shall be eligible to any office to be then voted for.

No person shall be permitted to vote at any election as aforesaid, other than white freeman of the age of 21 years or more, who shall have resided in this State at least one year, and in the election district to which he offers to vote, at least ten days immediately preceding such election.

Any person who has paid a State or county tax, and who shall have been assessed at least ten days before election. But a resident of the United States, who has previously been a qualified voter of this State, and removed therefrom, and returned, and paid taxes thereon, shall be entitled to vote after residing in this State six months, provided, that the white freeman citizens of the United States between the ages of 21 and 22 years and having resided in this State one year, and in the election district to which they shall not have paid taxes.

No person shall be permitted to vote who has not been named in the list of taxable inhabitants furnished by the Commissioners as aforesaid unless first he produces a receipt for the payment within two years of State or County tax assessed agreeably to the Constitution and give satisfactory evidence, showing that he has paid such tax, or second, if he claims a right to vote, by being an elector between the age of 21 and 22 years, he shall deposit with the Inspectors, at the time of his application in the State at least one year before his application and make such proof of residence in his district as required by this Act, and that he does verily believe from the account given him that he is of the age and give such other evidence as is required by this Act, whereupon the name of the person so admitted to vote shall be inserted in the alphabetical list by the Inspectors, and a note made opposite thereto by writing the word "tax" if he shall be admitted to vote by reason of having paid a tax of the word "age" if he shall be permitted to vote on account of his age, and neither case the reason of such vote shall be called out to the clerks, who shall name it in the list of voters kept by them.

If any person shall prevent or attempt to prevent any officer of an election, or shall interfere with him in the execution of his duty or shall block up or attempt to block the window or avenue or any window where the same may be held, or shall riotously disturb the peace of such election or shall use or practice any violence, or shall use or practice any violence, with design to influence unduly or overawe any elector to prevent him from voting or to restrain the freedom of choice, such person on conviction shall be fined in any sum not exceeding five hundred dollars and be imprisoned for any term not less than one nor more than twelve months; and if it shall be shown to the Court where the trial of such offence shall be had that the person so offending was not a resident of the city, ward, district, or township, he shall be committed to the County Jail, and be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than one hundred dollars and be imprisoned not less than six months or more than two years.

AN ACT Regulating the mode of voting at all elections, in the several counties of this Commonwealth.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the qualified voters of the several counties of this Commonwealth, at all general townships, borough and special elections, are hereby, hereafter, authorized and required to vote, by tickets, printed or written, or partly printed and partly written, severally classified as follows: One ticket shall embrace the names of all judges of the Court of Sessions, and be labelled, "judiciary"; one ticket shall embrace the names of all state officers voted for, and to be labelled, "state"; one ticket shall embrace the names of all township officers voted for, and to be labelled, "township"; one ticket shall embrace the names of all borough officers voted for, and to be labelled, "borough"; and each class shall be deposited in separate ballot-boxes, borough and special elections, are hereby, hereafter, authorized and required to vote, by tickets, printed or written, or partly printed and partly written, severally classified as follows: One ticket shall embrace the names of all judges of the Court of Sessions, and be labelled, "judiciary";
