Emory J. Pond, one of the hunters who accompanied Theo. Roosevelt on his African hunt, is one of the lion tamers employed with Sanger's Show. 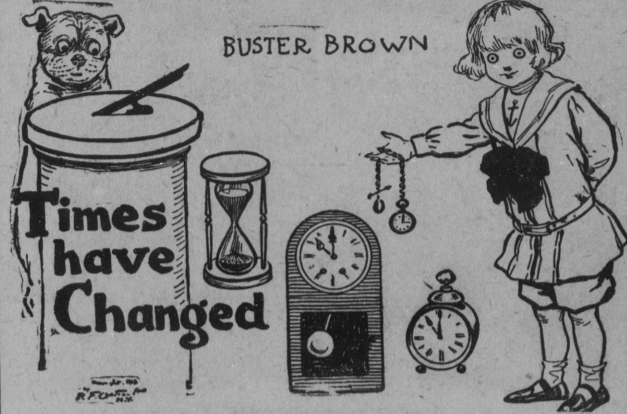
