There is some discussion as to the sarigin of the present national custom of observing Thanksgiving day. It was held by a large number of people, until recently, that the custom was first established by President Lincoln during the Civil war. Examination of the records showed that this was a mistake. A number of the presidents who preceded Mr. Lincoln issued Thanksgiving proclamations, the practice dating back to Washington. They had been desultory, however, and there had been no regular repetition of the had been no regular repetition of the clamation until after it had been is-

The custom of observing a day of thanksgiving and prayer is as old as the civilization of the country. It was manugurated in New England very shortly after the arrival of the first English immigrants, and it gradually became the day of all others in the wear, for surpassing Christmas in the emhusiasm and universality of its observance. In the southern states, prior to the Civil war, it was quite general, though there was no common day of catebration. The governors of the states issued their proclamations without reference to the dates set by the governors of other states, and it not states which the cole intrequently happened that the cele hardon would occur in Maryland on a cay different from that which was observed in the neighboring states. "I note with peculiar interest that you say 'the scales here appear to have been completely destroyed.' The parasites that I send you would certainly not be the creatures that de stroy it, and if there is no living San feed on it is useless for me to send you any. If you wish to obtain cimeas of the parasites, the best thing grains of corn—which shows conclusively that we are prosperous. The trusts are doing a noble work in remedying this evil condition.


