NO ADDITION

THIS YEAR

The erection of an addition to the Odd Fellows' Orphan Home, near Sunbury, has been held up for a year. At the annual meeting of the seventy representatives at the Home Tuesday the addition was discussed and it was learned that \$8000 had already been raised and that other money was in sight, but the committee decided that it would not be advisable to begin the work until at least \$25,000 was available, and for this reason no action will be taken for a year. In the meantime, however, the raising of funds will be pushed vigorously.

Among other business transacted yesterday, was the adoption of several slight changes in the by-laws and the adoption of a resolution to take the children of the Home to the meeting of the Grand Lodge, at Easton, in May, and the Odd Fellows' Anniversary Celebration at Montoursville in April.

What the Grangers Want.

The executive and Legislative Committee of the Pennsylvania State Grange met at Harrisburg last week and outlined a policy to be followed during the present year relative to State and National legislation. Candidates for the Legislature and Congress will have to explain their positions on the various questions in which the farmers are interested.

Those present were: W. F. Hill, Master, Franklin County; J. T. Allman, Secretary, Juniata County; A. M. Cornell, Bradford; Louis Pinnett, Bradford; G. W. Oster, Bedford; I. Frank Chanler, Chester and the Hon. W. T. Cressy, Columbia County.

They adopted a resolution asking any organization or society which may be interested in their reforms, such as parcels post, postal savings bank, a law which will compel the American manufacturer to offer his products as cheap in this country as abroad, permitting trolley roads to carry freight, and to relieve local taxation by allowing counties and municipalities to retain the balance of the personal property tax and all of the license tax now paid to the State. In regard to legislation they say:

"This organization is in favor of good roads, but believe that all classes of property should bear an equitable share in building and maintaining the roads. To effect this we believe that a tax of at least one mill should be placed on all personal and corporate property for road purposes, and that this money so raised should be applied to reduce local taxation."

A NINETEEN HOUR REVIVAL MEETING

HUNTINGTON, W. Va., Jan. 13.—A religious frenzy, the greatest the State has ever known, struck worshippers at Mount Vernon, Wayne county, twenty miles southeast of here. Rev. E. R. Kitchener, who has been conducting revival services here for two weeks, rose to deliver a sermon Monday evening at 7 o'clock. Before he had finished his exhortations more than half his congregation were on their knees in prayer, while others ran about the church, giving vent to their religious excitement. Hours passed and men, women and children stood like statues. Midnight came and the worshippers demonstrated continued and repeatedly. At the eleven o'clock service the religious fervor was at its height. Daylight dawned on Mount Vernon with the meeting still in progress. Not until 5 o'clock Tuesday afternoon did the meeting adjourn, none of the audience having taken food or drink in the nineteen hours that the demonstration continued. Some of the women present had to be carried from the church, owing to weakness and not yet at the height of people near the church. Nothing like it has ever before known in the history of the State. It is feared some of the worshippers will lose their reason.

Y. M. C. A. NOTES.

The Young Men's Christian Association are sending out this week a missionary to organize an Association at Havana, Cuba. Since the fall of Santiago the American Associations have had this responsibility before them.

Bishop Chandler of the Southern Methodist church first appealed to the International Committee to organize an Association in Havana. He wrote saying:

"While there I met many Protestant Christians, who repeatedly urged upon my attention the need of a Young Men's Christian Association in that city. I cannot overstate its importance. I write to ask if you can not induce some large-hearted philanthropist to supply the funds for the first year. After that it would be nearly self-supporting."

Representatives of the Christian churches in Havana have united in an appeal for an Association and promised support. The Committee has had so many large undertakings in foreign lands, for which it has raised nearly \$500,000 a year, that the funds were not available to send a secretary to Havana until the Young Men's Christian Association of the West Side, New York, and the Association of Virginia provided the support of an Association with a thoroughly trained secretary and equipment. The West Side Branch undertakes to raise \$10,000 within three years.

J. E. Hubbard, state college secretary of Virginia, has been appointed secretary, and sails for Havana next Thursday. Mr. Hubbard has been connected with the Association in the South from childhood, and during his course at Harvard held several offices in the University Association, which he was president in his senior year. He is something of an athlete, and for three years he trained with the track athlete team. He was a teacher in the South Carolina schools for four years after graduation.

For the present, rooms will be rented, but it is confidently expected that as the Association grows, funds will be provided for an Association building in Havana, costing at least \$100,000.

Major Hallard, who was for two years chairman of the Army Association at Manila, which is supported by American philanthropy, declared that an Association with a \$250,000 building in Manila would be more for that city to enhance American Christian ideas in the Philippines than any other one thing. The same could be said of Havana.
