By Tuesday evening everything was ready for throwing the stack and for the first thing Wednesday morning the blasting began.

The usual plan adopted in throwing furnace stacks was followed. A charge of dynamite was placed under each of the four legs supporting the mantle...

When the fuse connected with the four charges of dynamite which were to tumble the furnace were lighted the crowd stood silent with suppressed emotion and suspense.

This really was a contingency not looked for by the wreckers, as according to all theories the furnace should have fallen after the four shots.

Alexander Hamilton, the boss wrecker, is a man of too much push and nerve to permit the matter to remain long in doubt.

The reason why the stack refused to fall is thus explained: The furnace when shut down had not been blown out and in the bottom lay an immense salamander.

It was 9:30 o'clock when the crucial hour arrived and everything was ready to set off the second set of blasts.

The next job will be to laboriously cut the rivets, separating the iron plates and removing them along with the other iron used in the construction of the stack.

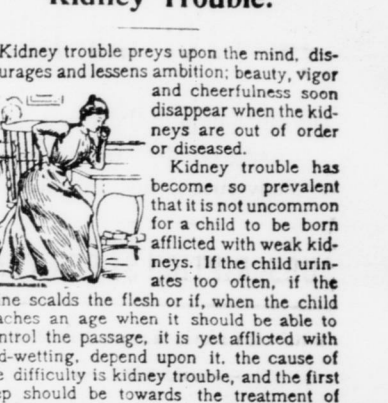
