HARRISBURG, Jan. 22. State Chairman W. R. Andrews last night issued a call for the next Republican State convention to be held in Harrisburg on Wednesday, April 29. The convention will name a candidate for Superior Court Judge, to succeed Judge W. D. Porter; 34 Presidential electors, including two at-large, and four delegates and four alternates-at-large to the Republican National convention at Chicago. The convention probably will elect a State chairman to succeed Colonel Andrews. Unless Chairman Andrews shall revise his plans he will not be a candidate for another term. Superior Court Judge Porter will be a candidate for re-nomination and to date has no opposition for another term.
