

The Mode of Procedure in Obtaining a City Charter—When it Will go into Effect.

Prior to the election there was much desire to know when and how a city government would be organized, and when it would go into effect, should consolidation carry.

The certificates of the election will be sent to the Secretary of the Commonwealth, and through him they will reach the Governor, who will then issue a charter.

On the third Tuesday of February, a Mayor and all other city officers will be elected. On the first Monday of April they will begin their duties, and until that time the different boroughs will manage their own affairs as at present.
