THE NEW CITY.

The Mode of Procedure in Obtaining a City
Charter—When it Will go Into Effect.
Prior to the election there was much desire to know when and how a city government would be organized, and when it would go into effect, should consolidation carry. Since we are to have a city, there is an increased desire to know just what steps will be taken. In that matter the mode of proceeding will be about as follows:

The certificates of the election will be sent to the Secretary of the Common-wealth, and through him they will reach the Governor, who will then issue a charter. Inside of sixty days it is the duty of the corporate authorities to make and send in the boundaries of the proposed city to the Governor. This will be necessary before the issuing of the charter.

On the third Tuesday of February, a Mayor and all other city officers will be elected. On the first Monday of April they will begin their duties, and until that time the different boroughs will manage their own affairs as at present.


