MARSHALL WINS BY DEMOCRATIC AID

Harrisburg, Jan. 8.—The machine forces, with the aid of five Democratic votes and one anti-Quay Republican vote, elected William T. Marshall speaker of the house.

The inducements which led these Democrats to the party were the wind all sense of obligation and political honor are known to themselves.

While disappointed at all sincere Republicans and friends of decent politics, the result is not decisive. Both senate and house of representatives will meet on Monday.

DEMOCRATS DID IT. The five Democrats who did this work were Col. J. Schuykill, Garvin of Adams, ex-Sen. Shutt and Kain of York, with assistance given by Rothrock in leaving the house at a vital moment.

So far as shown by the votes of yesterday there are not enough Quay Republicans in the legislature to elect Quay speaker.
