Cit WELLS OF JAPAN. Modern Methods of Drilling Have De-veloped Petroleum Industry. Mr. Rentiers, of the British Board of Trade a re-hate service in Japan, has submitted to the British Board of Trade a re-port on the petroleum industry, which has of late attracted much attention and reached considerable dimensions in that country. The only place in which the oil is produced in large quantifies is in the province of Ech-igo, on the west coast, the center of the industry being the town of Ar-nase, where the largest oil company in the country has been at work since 1888 with machinery imported from the United States. Here wells are dug in the sea and carried above the sea level by a double ring of plles filled in with earth. In the north-ern part of the province oil was dis-covered in 1889 and led to a fever of speculation. In 1892 there were be-working on a great scale and with imported machinery. Hand boring hands ceased to exist, and with improvement in methods of winning transport of the oil to the refineries. Fipe lines were introduced to convey it from the latter to the railway stations, and it has been proposed to Tokio, the capital, about two hun-dred miles away. 


