The action of President Roosevelt in reappointing Mrs. Catharine Endsley postmistress at Somerset borough will meet with the approval of a great majority of the patrons of the office. Her appointment, which was made originally by President McKinley, was generally recognized as his personal selection, and it would have been a great disappointment to the many friends at Somerset of the deceased president, as well as Mrs. Endsley, if a change had been made at this time. The political friends of Mr. R. S. Scull made an earnest but unsuccessful effort to have him appointed instead of the present official.—*Somerset Standard.*

WHAT are "Somerset county Mugwumps"? Those who fuse with the Democrats and none other. Several thousand "Mugwumps" voted for W. H. Ruppel, the Democratic nominee for President Judge, in 1901, as against Francis J. Kooser, the Republican candidate. They have probably learned by their action that fusion is useless among "the frosty sons of thunder" and that there are enough straight Republicans there to pull the ticket through, despite a combination of Democrats, soreheaded Mugwumps, Prohibitionists, etc., as was formed last fall. Pattison stands as the impersonation of a reckless, fatal candidity. He is doomed to defeat, and as he falls he will carry deeper into the mire of disrepute the faithless, futile Democracy which he unhappily leads."

BURGESS Fred Groff, of Berlin, was a Somerset visitor on Thursday, attending to business matters in the afternoon and driving home in the evening. Mr. Groff is a radical Prohibitionist and is the party's chairman in Somerset county. He admits that the prestige of his party has been somewhat weakened by the action of a majority of its members, last fall, when they voted the Democratic county ticket against the Prohibition nominee, but says that will not occur again. The Prohibitionists will take a new track, he says, and hereafter their efforts will be executed with a purpose of increasing the Prohibition vote. Prohibition alliances are being formed over the county and the members of them will circulate pledges among the voters asking them to pledge themselves in writing to support the Prohibition ticket in the fall.—*Somerset Standard.*

It is truthfully said of Mr. Morgan that he accomplishes none of his giant tasks by deceit or trickery, but works in the open. The North American has the following to say concerning the great financier, and all fair-minded and well posted men will admit that it is the truth:

"Who ever heard of J. Pierpont Morgan working a whole railway system, as Jay Gould was wont to do, in order to bring it within his grasp? Morgan builds up, Gould tore down. The Gould method is what Morgan brands as a game of bluff. A play with a false hand. A mere pretense instead of honest merit. Men were deceived into the belief that a pair of duces were four aces."
