

Mine of Timber in Russia.

A Russian timber dealer has dis-A Russian timber dealer has discovered a valuable mine of oak. It is in a river of South Russia, in layers three or four feet deep, scattered over 150 square miles, and its most striking feature is its variety of colors supposed to be due to the variegated soil of the river bottom. Not fewer than 12 shades of pink, blue, yellow and brown have been noted, each log having its own uniform shade. The logs taken out have ranged from 40 to 200 feet in length and from 15 to 20 inches in diameter, and it is estimated that more than 150,000 averaging 70 feet remain.—Chicago Journal.

NAVIGATION HELPS TRADE

Large Coal Shipments from Pitts burg, Coke from Connellsville Eclipses All Previous Records.

R. G. Dun & Co's. "Weekly Review

of Trade" says: Higher temperature is still needed to bring out full spring activity at many points, but improvement is discerned in almost all departments. Mercantile payments, are also more prompt, which adds materially to the feeling of confidence. Railway earnings, which have been falling behind in comparison with last year, were 8.1 per cent. large sale is rumored. Prices are and there is comparatively little complaint of freight congestion. A good boating stage has produced large coal shipments at Pittsburg, and the movement of coke from Connellsville eclipses all previous records. This free distribution of fuel testifies to the activity of manufacturing plants especially in the iron and steel industry.

Floods have done some damage on the Pacific coast, but farming prospects there, as in most other sections, are decidedly favorable. Large farm reserves of corn and oats are not accompanied by depressed prices, and the small wheat stocks are neutralized by most profitable quotations. Foreign commerce returns show unprecedented imports in February.

Good progress is noted in conditions at pig iron furnaces and steel mills. Contracts cover deliveries many months in advance, and a large sale is remored. Prices are well maintained, and the leading interest is expected to make a general increase of the per cent. in wages on April 1.

Outdoor work is still backward, but the prospective undertakings call for a big business in structural steel and higher prices are anticipated for wire products, sheets and plates. Railway supplies of all kinds are going on freely into consumption. Fall contracts come to New England shoemakers in very small volume and trade is being pushed by fraveling selesmen. Textile industries are making good progress, prices ruling firm, with a slight increase in the demand for cotton goods. Little new export business is noted, but large shipments continue on old orders. In the woolen goods division, prices of new lines show the expected advance over last season.
