A Sailor's Burial at Cherbourg.
The most impressive feature, however, of the day on which John Paul Jones' body arrived at Cherbourg was the real funeral of Seaman Rodgers of the Chattanooga, who died yesterday in the Civil hospital here from nephritis. In the afternoon los sailors and a firing squad of marines, accompanied by the scarlet coated band of the Brooklyn, marched to the hospital and received the body. The escort was augmented there by adetachment of French sailors and soliders and a number of professional spectators. Thousands of the inhabitants joined the cortege as it passed along, the band playing the Dead March in Saul. The body of blue jackets mourning their comrade marched in perfect alignment and step.
