

DUN'S WEEKLY SUMMARY.

Semi-Annual Statements Show First Half of 1906 Most Prosperous in Nation's History.

R. G. Dun. & Co.'s weekly "Review "Comparisons of the volume of cur-

responding date in previous years are so uniformly favorable that the are so uniformly favorable that the outlook can only be regarded with confidence. Semi-annual statements are now sufficiently complete to make it certain that the first half of 1906 was the most prosperous six-month period in the Nation's history, and, unless heavy cancellations occur, the last half of the year will establish a still higher record.

"Contracts come forward freely in the iron and steel industry, the only idleness being due to repairs necessitated by the vigor with which production has been pushed, and footwear factories are receiving orders for delivery next February, while even the textile mills report that purchasers have ceased efforts to secure more attractive terms.

"Complaints of inadequate labor supply are universal. Bullding operations are extensive, and would be much greater if the cost of labor and materials had not caused the abandonment of many plans.

"Aside from a little too much rain in some cotton States the week's crop news is encouraging, and grain will soon be out of danger. Buyers are arriving in the primary market in large number, placing orders freely and often urging quick delivery, which substantiates the claim that stocks are low in all positions.
