The remains were sent to his home, last Sunday, and on Tuesday, at 10 o'clock a. m., the funeral service was held at the Springs Mennonite church, conducted by Rev. S. G. Shetler, of near Johnstown.
 Deceased was aged nearly 21 years, and his death is greatly deplored by all who knew him. He was a consistent and faithful member of the Mennonite church, and was a young man of rare good qualities. He is survived by his parents, two brothers and two sisters.
