Sympathetic Strikes.
 John Mitchell will go down in history as one of the ablest Presidents the union miners ever had, and his parting injunction to the United Mine Workers is to avoid sympathetic strikes. "I have not seen any benefit accrue from any sympathetic strikes," he says.
 There may be isolated cases wherein one labor organization is aided by a sympathetic strike on the part of a kindred organization, but as a general rule President Mitchell's proposition is correct.
 Even where aid is rendered in this indirect manner to the cause of union labor, it is usually at the expense of the sympathizers. "Every tub should stand on its own bottom," is an old adage, and when the tub won't so stand, there is something radically wrong with its architecture.
 Union labor should be careful in its efforts to obtain its just reward that it does not do injustice to its employment. It is generally conceded that the man who killed the goose that laid golden eggs was a foolish fellow. Union labor is sometimes powerful enough to kill the goose, but killing reacts upon itself.
 Probably this is what John Mitchell meant.—Connellsville Courier.

B. & O. Employees Must Not Drink.
 Employees of the Baltimore & Ohio railroad having anything to do with the direction or running of trains will not be permitted to use intoxicants at any time hereafter—either on or off duty—and no person using such beverage will be employed, according to a general notice sent out by George L. Potter, third vice president and head of the operating department. Under no circumstances will exceptions be made.
 It is believed by the management of the road that this is an important step in the effort to reduce accidents to the minimum and raise the efficiency of the service and the safety of patrons in travel to the highest standard. The object of this action is plainly expressed in the first paragraph of the circular, which states: "For the protection of life and property and good of the service, rigid enforcement of the company's rules against the use of intoxicants is imperative."
