The framers of the new primary law intended to give political parties control of their own nominations, without interference from the enemies of the party. The ballots will be printed separately for that purpose, and the law defines the party qualifications when it provides that the elector must have voted at the last general election for a majority of the candidates of the party whose ballot he asks for. If he is challenged he must swear to this. The fact that a man is not challenged does not give him the right to vote with the party to which he does not belong. But there ought to be a challenge in every case where a citizen tries to take part in the nominations of another party than his own. Knowing the conditions of this law, no honest man will attempt to participate in the nomination of another party than his own, but if he does, he should be compelled to establish his right to a ballot by oath. Recently, some Democrats and Prohibitionists joined a number of Republicans in selecting two candidates for the Assembly for the more than eight thousand Republicans, and it is not improbable that some of the members of this committee will undertake to participate in the Republican nomination. No law will enforce itself, and an enforced law makes no distinction in the classes.—Somerset Standard.
