There is no doubt, however, that the number of accidents may be greatly lessened. and much benefit is anticipated from the action of Congress in appropriating \$150,000 to enable the United States Geological Survey to investigate the cause of mine explosions and make endations in relation thereto It is not the intention, as it is not the province of the Geological Survey to undertake any system of mine inspection or regulation, but simply to carry on research investigations, the results of which will be published for the ben-efit of all. The writer is of the opinior that one of the great needs of the coa that one of the great needs of the coar-mining industry is the enforcement of military discipline in the operation of the mines. Without such discipline the knowledge acquired through inestigation has proved of little avail."




