Somerset County Man Challenges World's Champion Prize Fighter.

According to a news dispatch from Fort Hill, this county, James Bonnell, a gigantic lumberman residing in that vicinity, recently issued a challenge, offering to fight Jack Johnston, the negro who now holds the world's pugilistic championship. The aforesaid dispatch contains the following information:

Mr. Bonnell in commenting on the challenge which he issued, said: "My challenge is for a rough-and-tumble, knock-out fight to a finish; no gloves, everything to go, no rules, and in clinches to be catch as catch can."

The exact meaning of this statement is not clear to local members of the sporting fraternity. The challenge was mailed to Johnston's manager, and Mr. Bonnell expects an answer within ten days.

Mr. Bonnell is about 55 years of age, and is reputed to be the strongest man in Somerset county. He has been engaged in the lumber business all his life, and has never injured himself in any way. He has never tasted liquor. He is unusually large and strongly built, his muscles are heavy and powerful, and his chest deep.

He was twice a candidate for office, once for Sheriff and once for Commissioner.

Local people are anxiously awaiting the answer to the challenge.

DESCRIPTION AND DIRECTIONS.—Sets on top (not in). Fits any stove. Is made of steel; cannot break. Is thoroughly practical and a genuine success. Open it and set on any stove having a flat surface. Grease the beveled edges of the little round pans, as well as the bottom, and put in your batter. As soon as done on one side, throw the little round pans over quick with a fork, and when the jar takes place, the cake will drop out of the round pans; then throw it back with a fork and refill with batter. In this way you can keep six cakes going at once, and can bake six cakes per minute, every cake the same thickness and exact size, and as light and sweet as griddle cakes can possibly be made.
