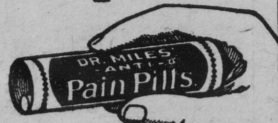

Koontz & Ogle, representing the Connellsville, Uniontown and Wheeling Railroad Company, presented a petition to court, recently, in which they asked that the report of viewers be confirmed. The court directed the papers to be filed, and to be confirmed, unless exceptions are filed within thirty days.

The Connellsville, Uniontown & Wheeling Company is a subsidiary concern of the B. & O., and is planning to build a large freight yard, and probably another road through the southern part of this county, in order to avoid the dangerous Sand Patch tunnel. The viewers appointed some time since by Judge Kooser to make an inspection and assess damages in favor of the property owners who failed to agree with the railroad company on the price to be paid for their land, were: J.
