RESOLUTION Proposing Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and caused to be affixed the seal of the Secretary's Office, the day and year above written.

FIRST AMENDMENT.

There shall be an additional article to said constitution to be designated as article eleven, as follows:

ARTICLE XI. OF PUBLIC DEBTS.

SECTION 1. The State may contract debts, to supply casual deficits or failures in revenues, or to meet expenses not otherwise provided for...

SECTION 2.

In addition to the above limited power, the State may, by assigning to any part of its lands, or any part of its stocks owned by the State, together with other funds, or resources, that may be designated by law...

SECTION 3.

Except the debts above specified in sections one and two of this article, no debt shall be contracted by, or on behalf of the State.

SECTION 4.

To provide for the payment of the present debt, and any additional debt contracted by the Legislature, shall, as its first section, be the adoption of this amendment, create a sinking fund...

SECTION 5.

The credit of the Commonwealth shall not be loaned to any individual, company, corporation or association; nor shall the Commonwealth hereafter become a joint owner, or stockholder, in any company, association or corporation.

SECTION 6.

The Commonwealth shall not assume the debt, or any part thereof, of any county, city, borough, or township, or of any corporation or association...

The Legislature shall not authorize any county, city, borough, township, or incorporated district, by virtue of a vote of its citizens or otherwise, to incur any debt, or to assume any liability, or to become a joint owner, or stockholder, in any company, association or corporation.
