HOW TO PLAY BACCARAT

THE RECENT GAME AT TRANBY CROFT, ENGLAND.

Little Known in America, but a Favorite with European Nobility—A Game of Pure Chance—How Cheating Can Be Done.

Several attempts have been made to describe the game of baccarat, but the results produced by those who would tell how the cards are manipulated have been such as to leave the reader with little knowledge of the game.

The game is very simple, known in America, and it is strictly a foreign affair. The nobility of Europe are fond of it, and the Prince of Wales seems to have been particularly fascinated with it.

Boyle says that baccarat is a game of pure chance, and bears some resemblance to "light-et-m" or "Twenty-one," but is a much more rapid game, and great fortunes can be won and lost at baccarat in an almost incredibly short space of time.

The game can be played with one or more packs of cards, usually in gaming with four packs or five packs, to make the art of shuffling easier.

The dealer may choose to shuffle them. The dealer may at his option say: "I will throw off three, or four, or six cards before opening the deal," and he may if he wishes place these rejected cards face upward on the table.

The object of the game is to secure nine, which is "game." This nine is secured by counting the spots on the spot cards. If the hand you hold, and only one card may constitute your hand, counts more than nine spots, you only can be credited with what spots you can count over ten.
