RYAN'S GREAT RECORD.

Toronto is Proud of an Oarsman Who Succeeds Hanley. John J. Ryan, the prominent oarsman whose portrait is herewith presented was born at Toronto, Ont., in 1862.

May 31, of the present year, he won the international road race, the course being from Bordeaux to Paris, a distance of 398 miles, in 20h. 35m., eclipsing Holben, the French rider's famous record of 39 1/2 miles in 24h.
