NORRISTOWN, June 6.—Some time ago town council adopted an ordinance increasing the salary of the burgess of Norristown from \$300 to \$700 per annum.

Burgess Shaffer, to test the borough's authority for attempting to dispose of the fees of his office, began proceedings, and yesterday the court handed down an opinion, in which it is decided that the burgess of Norristown is a committing magistrate, and as such is entitled to the emoluments of the office the same as a regularly constituted justice of the peace, and that town council, whilst it may regulate the salary of the burgess, has no right to the fees of the office. It now remains to be seen whether council will reduce the salary to the original sum.
