CHINA TAKES A HAND.

The Celestial Empire Will Espouse the Cause of Siam. RUSSIA WILL SUPPORT FRANCE. Great Britain Sees the Necessity for Action, and Sends Special Instructions to Her Fleet in the Orient—Report That Siam's King Is to Leave Bangkok.

PARIS, July 21.—A dispatch received here from Bangkok states that the Siam government is greatly agitated. Preparations are apparently under way for the departure of the king and his court from the capital.

LONDON, July 21.—A special cabinet meeting was summoned in Downing street yesterday afternoon. There was a full attendance. France's demands in Siam were discussed at length, and eventually the instructions for the Marquis of Dufferin, British ambassador to France, were formulated and approved.

WASHINGTON, July 21.—The bimetallic state convention chose ex-Governor Osborne as permanent chairman. The address preceding the election was made by a delegate making a universal gold standard, making this his last Secretary's address.

WASHINGTON, July 21.—General John G. Walker died at his residence in this city today of a stroke of paralysis. He was 70 years of age and lived in Winchester, Va.

NEW ORLEANS, July 21.—Yesterday afternoon Cashier James M. Dowling, of the United States mint, was arrested on a charge of embezzling \$25,000 from the government. He was arraigned and pleaded not guilty.

DENVER, July 21.—The closing down of many silver mines, smelters and the reduction of working forces of coal mines, railroads and manufacturing in the state has caused a deplorable condition of affairs among the working classes.
