INCOME TAXES ABROAD

Great Britain Collects Sixty-five Million Dollars Annually.

PRUSSIA'S SYSTEM OF TAXATION. It Has a Tendency to Reduce the Tax on Small Incomes and Increase It on Large Ones—Austria Collects Ten Millions and Italy Forty-five Millions.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 10.—Representative Ryan, of Nebraska, on behalf of the committee on ways and means, submitted an elaborate statement concerning the various systems of income tax in operation in Europe.

Great Britain is shown to have imposed an income tax continuously since 1842. The rate of the tax has varied from year to year, never being below two pence on the pound sterling.

Another Immigration Bill. WASHINGTON, Jan. 10.—Representative Lockwood, of New York, introduced in the house a bill for the restriction of immigration and to amend the contract labor laws.
