DEATH OF DR. MCOSH.

The Distinguished Educator Succumbs to Old Age.

HIS WORK FOR PRINCETON COLLEGE

During His Twenty Years' Administration as President of That Institution the Number of Pupils More Than Doubled, and Many Reforms Were Effected.

PRINCETON. N. J., Nov. 17.—The venerable Dt. James McCosh, A. M., ex-president of Princeton college, died at his home here at its o'clock last might. The cause of his death was the general debility incident to o'd age, and he passed away without a straight. Since Dr. McCosh retired from the presidentsy of the college he has lived in the privacy of home in Princeton. His has public appearance of note was at the congress of higher education at Chicago in 1866. He was the most venerable and impressive figure of that great path. and impressive figure of that great gathering. Crowds flocked to see him in the streets, and distinguished educators of the old and new world called to do him honor. During the past summer his strength began to fall fast, and on his return to Princeton this fall it was evident he had

Dr. James McCosh will rank as one of the foremost metaphysicians of the century,

a worthy pupil of the great Dr. Chal-mers and of the eminent Sir William Hamilton. He was born in Ayr-shire, Scotland, at-tended the universities of Glasgow and Edinburgh, and was ordained a minister of the Church of Scot land in 1825. His first settlement as paster was at Bre-chin in 1850; in 1843

DR. M'COHH. he took part in the memorable disruption of Secteb Presbyterianism and the forms

ion of the Free Church of Scotland.

In 1851 Dr. McCosh was appointed pro fessor of logic and metaphysics in Queen's callege, Belfast, Ireland. In 1888 he was called to the presidency of Princeton col-lege, which position he held for many years until he was retired as president emerius, and succeeded in the active du-ties by the Rev. Dr. Francis L. Patton. Dr. McCosh's career as president of the college of New Jersey was marked with narrectons success. He elevated the char-acter of the institution, and instilled his own enthusiasm into the faculty and the pupils. His management impelled the respect of the friends of the university, and during his presidency nearly \$3,000,000 flowed to the treasury in the form of offer-ives and beaucats. emornia, and succeeded in the active du-ties by the Rev. Dr. Francis L. Patton.

During the administration of Dr. Me-Cosh the number giving instruction in the college was increased from ten professors, four mans and two teachers to thirty-five four enters and two teachers to thirry-five professors, these tutors and several assist-ants and lecturers—in all upward of forcy. The increase in the number of students has been correspondingly great. In 1895, the catalogue of the college estimated the number at 25. In 1885, the year of Dr. Mot cosh's retrement the catalogue showed the number of students to be 604. During the same period a great work was wrought in sumpling out semi-barbarous college mations among the undergraduate body, once of which had come down from enmial times and were expled from England. 
