SATOLLI ON SCHOOLS.

The Papal Delegate Writes of Rome's Educational Systems, CATHOLIC SCHOOLS IN THE LEAD.

These Schools, Mgr. Satolli Declares, Are More Patriotic and More Italian in Spirit and Method Than the Secular Schools.

New York, Nov. 28.—In an article on the Catholic school system in the December number of The North American Review, Mgr. Satolli makes his first contribution to American periodical literature.

Mgr. Satolli devotes his article to a review of the foundation of Catholic schools in Rome by private funds independent of the Italian school system after the government had succeeded in eliminating Catholic influence from the educational institutions.

Mgr. Satolli says that in number the Catholic schools exceed the government and municipal schools combined. In regard to the qualifications of teachers, the text books and programs and the method of teaching the Catholic schools endeavor to adjust themselves as far as possible to the requirements of the state.

CHARGES OF FRAUD.

South Carolina's Legislature Petitioned to Investigate. DR. POPE'S SENSATIONAL CLAIMS.

The Defeated Independent Candidate for Governor Declares That Friends at the Polls Were Committed by the Commission of Governor Tillman and Senator Irby.

COLUMBIA, S. C., Nov. 28.—In a petition to the general assembly asking for an investigation of the recent election which Dr. Sampson Pope, the defeated independent candidate for governor of South Carolina, filed yesterday, charges are made that United States Senator Irby and Governor Tillman instigated frauds to secure the election of John Gary Evans, the Tillman candidate.

Lawyer Murdered by a Milkman. CHICAGO, Nov. 28.—Edward P. Hilliard, an attorney in the Rookery building, was shot and killed yesterday afternoon by Henry C. Hastings, a milk dealer.

Militia Companies Disbanded. SACRAMENTO, Cal., Nov. 28.—As a result of the findings of the court of inquiry, which investigated the actions of the state militia during the recent strike troubles, Governor Mackay has ordered that Company A, of the Second Infantry regiment, and Company G, of the Third Infantry, be mustered out of the service.
