THE NEW BANKING BILL.

As Amended by the House Currency Committee. NEW PROVIDED FOR STATE BANKS.

They May Issue Notes on Paper Similar to That Used in Printing United States Certificates, but Must Not Imitate Them Nor National Bank Notes.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 22.—After conferences between the Democratic members of the house committee on banking and currency, and with the approval of the secretary of the treasury, Mr. Springer yesterday introduced a substitute for the Carlin currency bill.
