GIFFTS FOR BISMARCK.

Every Train Bears the Germans' Tokens of Esteem.

VAST CROWDS AT FRIEDRICHSBURG

In All Parts of Germany the People Are Wild with Enthusiasm in Celebrating the Veteran Statesman's Birthday—Fires Burning on Every Elevation.

FRIEDRICHSBURG, April 1.—The Bismarck celebration is in full swing, and every day seems to add to the enthusiasm displayed by the German people over the 80th anniversary of the birth of the old chieftain.

Today, the actual anniversary of the prince's birth, witnesses such a popular demonstration as has not been witnessed since the return to Berlin of the Prussian army from France.

For the first time since the beginning of the celebration in his honor Prince Bismarck on Saturday was somewhat fatigued and indisposed, his old trouble, neuritis, troubling him slightly.

Yesterday the prince received his first congratulatory telegram from a crowned head outside of Germany.

One of the features of the Bismarck celebration at Hamburg was the holding on Saturday night of a "comers," organized by the reichesting electoral union.

Yesterday all the public and a majority of the private buildings in Hamburg were decorated with flags and bunting in honor of the occasion.

The view of the city last night from the Aussen-alster and Binnen-alster was a beautiful one. The Lombards bridge, which spans the connection between these two bodies of water, was a change of glory.

The main streets of the city were until a late hour almost impassable. Many visitors to Hamburg were early to start for Friedrichsburg.

Throughout Germany last night joy flags burned on the highest mountain peaks and hills from the Baltic and the North seas on the north to the Swiss and Austrian frontiers on the south.

The Berlin papers comment upon the enormous number of gifts of estates that have been sent to Prince Bismarck.
