COLUMBIA THE WINNER

Cornell Comes in Second in the Tri-College Race.

ELEMENTS FAVORED THE CONTEST.

The Course in Perfect Condition and the Rowmen Not Molested by Other Craft. Pennsylvania's Shell Sinks After She is Fairly Defeated.

POUGHKEEPSIE, N. Y., June 25.—The four mile stretch of Hudson river water opposite Poughkeepsie has been christened as an intercollegiate course by the contest which was won last night by Columbia...

It is scarcely fair to say that either crew was outclassed by the other, unless it be that Cornell, to her light, snappy form, was not the least antagonist of so powerful and steady a crew as Columbia...

Of the course as a waterway for a shell race it may be said that, when taken at its best and when used in its fairer moods, there could be none more desirable or satisfactory...

There were very few boats at the course yesterday, as compared with last Friday. The Grand Republic came up with her decks swarming, and two or three other excursion boats were there...

The race was started by the word from the referee at 6:13 a. m. Cornell got the water first with a crisp first stroke, but lost it almost before it could be detected by spectators...

The first mile was finished in five minutes, at 6:58, and in the first stretch of the second mile the crews encountered wind against tide, and all were splashing...

AT the two miles Columbia was rowing at thirty-six to the minute, while Cornell, at forty-two, was splashing some in an effort to gain...

Columbia entered the third mile fifteen seconds ahead of Cornell, while Pennsylvania was third by thirty seconds.

From this on to the end of the third mile it was a race in procession, Columbia gaining on Cornell, and Cornell gaining on Pennsylvania...

Cornell lost steadily, though slowly. An eighth of a mile below the bridge, with the leaders twelve boat lengths in advance, Pennsylvania was swamped by the chop of the tide...

The race was rowed in 21:20, a minute and ten seconds below the New London record.
