THE QUAKE IN NEW JERSEY. The Disturbance Affected Only the North-

ern Portion of the State.

JERSEY CITY, Sept. 2.—New Jersey felt the force of the earthquake, the tremor extending throughout the northern part, while the southern section appears to have escaped the experience entirely. From all of the cities and villages in the northern or the effices and vinages in the normality section the story received is the same. The shock was preceded and accompanied by the low rumbling sound that marks the true earthquake. This trembling motion lasted for several seconds. In some places the estimate of time is as low as three seconds, while others place the duration of the disturbance at from ten to twenty seconds. The general course of the shock was from east to west.

Trenton and Bordentown report that the earthquake came with a loud rumbling sound, which was at first thought to be the wind or the ratiling of a heavy wagon. There was a very perceptible vibration, the shaking of houses and the rattling of windows being plainly feit.

MEXICO'S FIERCEST STORM. Many Miles of Railroads Washed Away

and Traffic Entirely Suspended. LAREDO, Tox., Sept. 2.-Information re-garding the fearful storm of Friday, extending from Corpus Christi and across the border several hundred miles into Moxico, is very meager. Scarcely anything definite can be learned, as the railroad of-ficials are very reticent. Enough is known, however, to state that the storm is the worst in the history of northern Mexico. First reports were to the effect that the telegraph wires and railway tracks would be in working condition on Saturday, but

advices this morning indicate that wires to the City of Mexico over the Mexican National railway will not be set levable until this afternoon and official sources would indicate the abandonment of through trains until the latter part of the week. Flys miles of Mexican National Tele-

graph wires are down, with numerous bridge swashed away. In many places the Mexican National coulded is washed out for several hundred yards. At one point 80 yards of the track was washed into a stand river and twisted into all sorts of sluop s. Steam Yacht Yankee Doodle Aflame.

PHILADELPHIA, Sept. 2. - The steam racing yacht Yankee Doodle, owned by McBride Brothers, of this city, was damaged by five yesterday to such an extent as to incapacitate her for service hereafter, The Messre, McBride, with a party of twelve friends, had steamed down the Schuylkill river on a pleasure trip. Near the foot of the city a quantity of oil escaped from the tank and became ignited. The party was safely landed, but the boat's machinery was damaged to the extent of \$6,000, and she was otherwise injured. A mile record of one minute and forty see onds was claimed for the Yankee Doodle.

Germany's Celebration of Victory.

BEBLIN, Sept. 2.—It is evident that the German nation, especially the Berliners, German uniton, especially the Herliners, intend to celebrate the anniversary of the battle of Sedan in a peaceful but de-termined manner. The capital presents such a spectacle as has seldom been seen. The newspapers all agree that it is a demonstration to the honor of United Ger-many and not a manifestation of satisfaction at the defeat of the French. The jar-ring tones of the socialists, who were at-tempting a demonstration of disapproval of the celebration, find little echo among the people, and the projected anti-demon strations have been abandoned.

Cowden, of this city, in Camden, on Aug. 15, has taken steps to contest Cowden's applica tion for divorce. The young bride denies the story widely published that her husband is only 16 years of age, and that he was under the influence of drugs when the ceremony was performed. She says she is prepared to prove that young Cowden was most persistent in his attempt to carry her off to a clergyman, while her father tried to prevent him from seeing her. Her husband, she says, is 22 years old.
