Many Veterans Exchange Greetings at Louisville.

LADIES TO UNITE IN ONE ORDER.

It is Proposed to Bring the Women's Relief Corps and Ladies of the G. A. R. Into One Organization in Order to Carry Out Their Work on a Greater Scale.

LOUISVILLE, Sept. 10.—Probably the most important business that will be transacted at the present juncture will be the joining of the Women's Relief Corps and the Ladies of the G. A. R. in one order.

The Michigan Mine Horror. Houghton, Mich., Sept. 10.—The situation at the Osceola copper mine, where thirty miners are entombed, remains about the same. Captain Richard Edwards and a couple of men went down as far as the second level in shaft No. 1 to make some repairs to the pump, but they suddenly felt themselves being overcome by the gas and started up.

Tortured and Robbed. TORONTO, Sept. 10.—Three masked men entered the house of John Bullock, a farmer near this town, and tied Mrs. Bullock securely to her bed. Her screams woke Bullock, but he was immediately tied and gagged. The burglars demanded money, and when Bullock refused they roasted his feet until the agony was un bearable.

A Tailor Arrested for Smuggling. NEW YORK, Sept. 10.—Louis Meyer, of Baltimore, a tailor, was arrested in Hoboken as he disembarked from the North German Lloyd steamship "Fulda," on a charge of smuggling. The inspectors found all dress goods and jewelry to the value of \$600 in his trunk, upon which the duty would be \$150.

A Lady Crissal Doing the Globe. CLEVELAND, Ind., Sept. 10.—Miss Landonberry, the lady cyclist who left Boston June 25, 1894, to make a tour of the world within fifteen months, arrived here yesterday from the west.

Baltimore, Sept. 10.—Pilot Carroll, of the steamer Corona, reports the schooner Elm City ashore in the Craighill channel on the west side. She appears about one foot out of water below her floating draught. The Elm City sailed from here on Saturday for Boston.

MIMIC WAR AT STETIN.

Interesting Scenes Attending the Kaiser Manoeuvres.

WILLIAM LEADS THE CHARGE

The Imperial Excursionists Honored by Elaborate Illuminations and a Grand Display of Fireworks Along the Route of Their Journey on the River Oder.

STETIN, Sept. 10.—The Third and Ninth army corps and the guards began their mimic war operations yesterday when Emperor William and his suite assumed a position on the Peenitz Hills, on the outskirts of the advance guards of the southern division.

The emperor rode at the head of the charge. Cavalry divisions, military attaché to the United States embassy, followed the charge throughout, but Colonel Swatlow, the military attaché to the British embassy, was obliged to dismount. The northern army then concentrated upon Greifenhagen, while the southern army marched upon Kuetzow, leaving the country, somewhat upon their flank, entirely unmolested.

The operations were controlled from a capitol balloon, shaped like a cigar, which floated above the moving masses. At a banquet last evening, Emperor Francis Joseph sat at the right and the King of Saxony at the left of Emperor William. The guests included the Count of Turin, the Princess of Turin, Prince Leopold of Bavaria, Prince Albrecht of Prussia and Maximilian of Baden.

The imperial excursion proceeded as far as Glienicke, where the party witnessed a representation of a fire at sea. Among the illuminations were the inscriptions "Well to the Emperor," "Thou Art Ours and We Are Thine," The Vikingship at the Vulkan works was a splendid electric effect.

A Thrilling Horseback Ride.

WEST CHESTER, Pa., Sept. 10.—Mrs. C. G. Papsch, of Philadelphia, who is summing at Dr. Baker's, two miles outside of West Chester, was the victim of an exciting runaway last evening. She mounted a horse to take a ride and the animal became frightened and ran away.

A Farmer's Narrow Escape.

ATLANTIC CITY, Sept. 10.—August Boehm, a Backersville, Atlantic county, farmer, narrowly escaped being killed by a Camden and Atlantic railroad train. The engine struck the wagon and demolished it, throwing Boehm about thirty feet in the air.

Another Royal Betrothal.

BERLIN, Sept. 10.—Princess Alexandra of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha, third daughter of the Duke of Edinburgh, was formally betrothed to the Hereditary Prince Ernest of Hohenzollern-Langenburg. Princess Alexandra is 17 years of age and Prince Ernest 22.

Cholera on the Increase.

LONDON, Sept. 10.—An Odessa dispatch says that there has been an increase of cholera at Volkhuu, and that 250 deaths are occurring daily in the government of Egoria. Ezerum is also seriously infected.

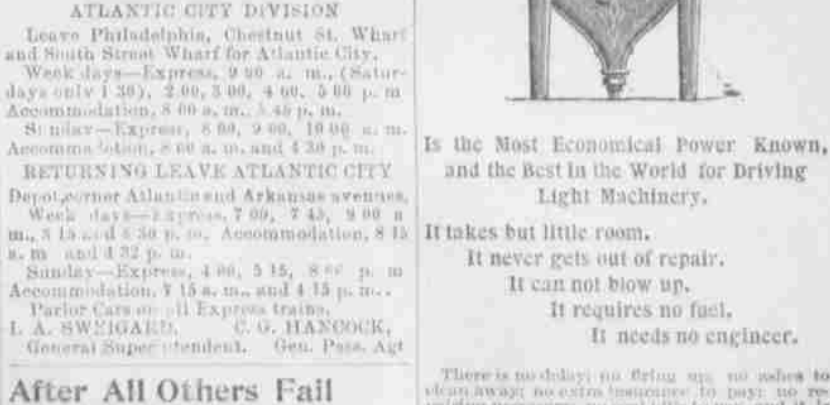
