The Lyon-Dunn Contest.
Attorney General McCormick yesterday afternoon heard argument in the petition of Judge T. H. R. Lyon to contest the election of P. M. Dunn as Orphan's Court Judge. The lawyers for Mr. Dunn opposed the petition on the ground that the law made no provision for a contest of this character; that the petition and affidavit were not properly prepared; that the affidavit was not sufficient because it was not sworn to before a proper officer, as his residence is not given, not even the county or state in which he resides, and therefore there is nothing to show that he was competent to administer the oath. The Lyon people quoted authorities to show that the law did apply to contests like the one proposed. The Attorney General is holding the matter under advisement, and a dispatch from Harrisburg states that he will refer the matter to the Governor for the appointment of Judges to conduct the contest.
