NICARAGUA REVOLUTION.

The Revolutionists Will Probably Make an Attack Upon Managua. MANAGUA, Nicaragua, Feb. 26.—The flag of rebellion has once more been raised in Nicaragua, and reports received here from the north show that the whole district north of Lake Managua is in open rebellion against President Zelaya.

The sum and substance of the demands of the Leonists is a complete revision of the constitution, giving further and more popular representation, and that the constitution in future should contain certain provisions making it impossible for a dictatorship to be declared.

President Zelaya has a number of troops forty miles west of this city, but he is without information as to the exact designs of the revolutionists. The forces of the Conservative party have all rallied to the support of the president during the present crisis.
