THE SCHOOL BOARD.

Contract for the White Street School Building Awarded.

The School Board held a regular monthly meeting last night and it was attended by all the Directors except Mr. John T. Lee, whose absence was caused by the death of his brother at St. Clair.

The most important business of the evening was that bearing upon the construction of the new White street school building. After a recess of 10 minutes the committee on building and repairs submitted its report showing the following bids:

Superintendent Whitaker made his monthly report as follows: Term enrollment—Boys, 1903; girls, 1882; total, 3185. Monthly enrollment—Boys, 1209; girls, 1345; total, 2554.

After instructing the building and repairs committee to prepare the contract and bond and other preliminaries attendant upon the erection of the new White street school building, and acting upon bills, the Board adjourned to meet upon the call of the chair for general business.
