DEATH OF MRS. STOWE.

Writer of the Famous Slave Story, "Uncle Tom's Cabin," ONE OF A REMARKABLE FAMILY.

Phenomenal Success of Her Greatest Work, Which Paid Her \$400,000 in Royalties, She Being Too Poor at the Outset to Share the Expense of Publication.

HARTFORD, July 2.—Mrs. Harriet Beecher Stowe, the gifted authoress of "Uncle Tom's Cabin," "Dred," and other works of world wide reputation, died at her home, No. 73 Forest street, yesterday, without regaining consciousness. She passed peacefully away, as though into a deep sleep. By her bedside at the time were her son, the Rev. Charles Stowe, of Simsbury; her two daughters, Eliza and Harriet; her sister, Mrs. Isabella Beecher Hooker, and her husband, the Hon. John Hooker, Dr. Edward B. Hooker, her nephew, who was her medical attendant, and other relatives.

Mrs. Stowe's malady of many years' continuance, a mental trouble, took an acute form on Friday, when congestion of the brain with partial paralysis appeared. During Friday, Saturday and Sunday Mrs. Stowe was about the house, but suffering very much. Since Monday morning she has been confined to her bed, and on Tuesday afternoon she became unconscious.

Mrs. Stowe's body will be taken to Andover, Mass., tomorrow. The burial will be in the cemetery connected with the Andover Theological seminary, where Mrs. Stowe's husband, Professor Calvin E. Stowe, and her son Henry are buried.

It was the good fortune of Dr. Lyman Beecher, the most famous Congregational clergyman of his time, and one of the most eloquent pulpits orators of any age, to be the parent of several children who were to shed greater lustre upon the family name even than that which he himself conferred upon it. The best known of these were Henry Ward, Harriet, Thomas, Catherine and Edward. Of these, Catherine was born in 1810, Edward in 1804, Harriet in 1813, Henry Ward in 1813 and Thomas in 1821. The most celebrated was Henry Ward and Harriet.

Harriet Beecher Stowe's birthplace was Litchfield, Conn., and on June 15 she emigrated to Hartford, Conn.

AN OHIO STRIKE RIOT.

Polish Quarry Strikers Resist a Sheriff's Posse.

ONE OF THE MOB FATALLY HURT.

Women Take a Hand in the Conflict, and Drive Out the Workmen Who Had Taken the Strikers' Places—Militia Called Upon to Aid the Sheriff.

WESTVIEW, O., July 2.—Over a hundred shots were exchanged by deputy sheriffs and strikers yesterday at the Beron stone quarries. No one was killed so far as now known. One striker had his leg broken in two places, and many have sore heads as the result of a hand to hand conflict. The strikers approached the quarries through the woods with the avowed intention of driving out the non-union men at work. They were met by the sheriff and forty deputies, who commanded them to stop. For an answer the strikers began firing and the fight then became general. The strikers were finally repulsed and fell back to the woods.

While the strikers were at Westview the women in overwhelming numbers took the quarry by storm and drove out the workmen with clubs and strong language. The sheriff was at Westview with all but a handful of his deputies, and in consequence the women had full sway. When the news reached them that some of the strikers had been injured at Westview the women were beside themselves with rage, and were only kept in check by the large number of citizens that were hastily summoned from the village. The strikers are rapidly returning from Westview, and have been calling in their pockets for the purpose of arming them.

Sheriff Leek finds that he cannot cope with them, as they scatter and slip across lots at such a lively rate that he cannot keep all points guarded with his men. The strikers would not allow any one to cross their line after the fight, so it was not possible to learn how many of their number had been injured. Some of the sheriff's party were hurt.

The strikers now claim that Deputy Sheriff Smith did the first shooting, and in consequence they are more bitter than ever. The stone company is bound to keep its works running, and will insist on the utmost protection. Four companies of the Fifth regiment have been called on to aid the sheriff.

Four Polish strikers were wounded in the melee at Westview. Vincent Maschinski is shot through the lungs and will die. He is 38 years old and has a wife and four children. Martin Rookowski was wounded in the chin, and Joseph Wawzanski and Anton Polak were slightly wounded in the legs.

The strikers have sworn out warrants for the arrest of Deputy Sheriff Smith and other deputies, charging them with shooting with intent to kill.
