LITTLE HOLE, July 31. - A statement was widely published by the press a few days ago that President G. L. Greens, of the Connectiont Life Insurance company, of Hartford, had issued a circular latter to policy bolders notifying them that in the event that the government adopted the free compelies to pay all claims in depre-cated silver coln. Mr. F. W. Alsop, of this circ, sent a clipping of this statement to Socratary of the Treasury Carlisle with a request for an expression on the subject.

CARLISLE ON SILVER.

a request for an expression on the subject. He has received a reply from Mr. Carlisle, in part as follows: "In case free coinage of sliver should be established in this country I presume insur-ance companies and all other institutions would continue to make their payments by checks and drafts on banks, as heretofore. In up opinion the whole volume of our currency would sink at once to the silver busis, and these checks and drafts would be paid in silver dollars or their equivalent instead of gold or its equiva

"I presume no one suppose for a mo-ment that it would be the duty of the gov-ernment to attempt to heap the standard allyer dollar coined free for private indisilver dollar coined free for private indi-viduals and corporations, equal in value to a gold one; or, in other words, that it would be the duty of the government to attempt, under a system of free coinage, to maintain the parity of the two metals. The dollars would be coined on private account and delivered to private individ-uals and compositions as their own man unls and corporations as their own prep-erty, the government having no interest whatever in them, and being, therefore, under no obligation to sustain them by guaranteeing their value.

"Under our existing system all silver dollars are coined on account of the pov-ernment, and are based by the government in payment of its expenditures and other obligations, and it would be an acr of had faith therefore to perialt them to depreciate


